

FIRST GRADE AT HOME WORK

Reading: Read for at least 20 minutes a day

• Read to your sibling, adults, pets, etc.

Writing: Write for 20-30 minutes a day

- 3 or more sentences
 - o Capital letters
 - o Punctuation
- A few ideas:
 - o Write a letter to your teacher
 - o Write a make believe story
 - o Write about what you did that day
 - Write about the book you are reading

Math: Practice math for 20-30 minutes a day

- Practice your math facts (+1, +2, etc)
 - o Time yourself each day and try to beat your best time
 - o Roll 2 dice and add or subtract
 - Use a deck of cards, pull two cards and add or subtract
- Go on a shape hunt around your house
 - Count the number of triangles, circles, squares, etc.
- Count by 2's, 5's, 10's
- Write numbers to 120 neatly

Additional ideas:

- Create a fire escape plan for your family
- Watch the moon each night and track the changes
- Create different surveys and ask your family for their opinions
- Design a new playground for Lockwood
- Go on a nature walk and draw and label animals and plants you see
- Find words around the house and make a list
